God had a specific role for Moses. In Romans 12, Paul tells us that God has specific roles for us as well. Paul has just finished explaining God’s plan of salvation through Jesus Christ—how God gives us Christ’s righteousness so that we may be saved. Now he urges us to respond by giving ourselves to God in service—as Moses did. But Paul also urges us to serve humbly, recognizing that our gifts come from God and that our fellow believers in the body of Christ also have gifts.
