In our very first session we looked at the question **“Who Am I?”**. That is a legitimate question since we all want to know who the really me is. In the sessions that followed we reviewed that we are important to God and He proves that we are of value and loved by Him. Remember that we aren't "junk" but we have been made in the very image of God. So you and I are something special! Well, if we are special then what? What I mean is, "what are we to do now"? This leads us to ask another very important life question. **“Why Am I here?”** What is our purpose for being here at this time and in this place? Are we here by chance and just to live as we please? Our lives must have a purpose or otherwise "why are we here"? It is to the finding out of life's purpose that we explore in this session.

Jesus Christ is our number one example to discover the answer to our question, "Why Am I here?". Let's look at His life and learn the purpose(s) for being here and now.




